



# Building Champions On and Off the Field

## A Interview With Physical Education Facilitator

**Blending passion with purpose, the school's sports ecosystem is redefining holistic education. Here's an inside look.**

**Interviewer:** Sports today go far beyond recreation. How does the school's sports programme cater to the needs of students?

**Mr Manikant:** The school's sports programme promotes holistic development by improving physical fitness, stamina, and overall well-being. Regular sports participation strengthens immunity, builds muscular strength, and helps prevent lifestyle diseases, effectively balancing academic and physical growth.



**Interviewer:** How does participation in sports help in identifying and nurturing students' talents?

**Mr Manikant:** Inter-class and inter-house competitions provide platforms to identify hidden talent. These events build confidence and discipline, while talented athletes receive guidance and exposure through CBSE, SGFI, and higher-level competitions.

**Interviewer:** The school has made significant advancements in sports infrastructure. Could you highlight the recent developments?

**Mr Manikant:** In collaboration with the PRPC Sports Complex, the school has developed modern facilities, including badminton courts, a swimming pool, basketball and volleyball courts, cricket and football grounds, and tennis courts.

**Interviewer:** How have these infrastructural developments enhanced training, performance, and safety of student athletes?

# The God's Unseen Hand


